INDOOR RANGE SCHEDULE AND POLICIES  
EFFECTIVE 10/1/12 TO 4/1/13

The attached schedule reflects the shooting needs of the many involved interest groups at WRC. It is an attempt to recognize the long established traditions of the club as well as merge the newer archery program.

WRC is an affiliated NRA member club with an emphasis on precision Olympic style marksmanship.

The archery program also has an emphasis on FITA and Olympic style formats. WRC is a USA Archery affiliated JOAD club.

Finally, individuals or small groups who have tenure in the club have been authorized and approved by the officers of WRC to use the range during non "prime time" hours. They have been granted the use of a building key.

Here are a few policies so that all members can enjoy the benefits that WRC can offer.

- 1) An official calendar will be kept updated with all WRC activities and events that use the facility. It will be posted online at [www.wheatonrifleclub.org](http://www.wheatonrifleclub.org) Please check the schedule before traveling to the club to see if any changes have been made from the "norm". The online schedule will often reflect changes to accommodate scout groups, NRA classes, NRA training sessions, and archery classes. These sessions will have been approved by the elected officers of WRC, and often will be generating income for the club. There will also be several weekends dedicated to state and regional tournaments.
- 2) "Priority" times are marked on the schedule as Adult Rifle, Youth Rifle, JOAD (Youth) Archery, Adult Archery, and Air Pistol. These times are reserved for those shooting groups who will have first privilege to use the range.
- 3) "Open" times are just that...open for individuals or small groups who have been granted key privileges on an unreserved first come/first served basis.

With the schedule in place, conflicts should be minimal. Hopefully if a conflict should occur, a resolution through polite and reasonable conversation should make all parties happy.
