Just as a reminder here are some of the long standing rules of the Western Rifle League.

- Teams can only use the scores of dues paid club members. Guests welcome to shoot for score only.
- You must start and finish the season with the same team.
- Home teams are responsible to open the facilities by 7pm
- Ties are broken by highest offhand then kneeling and so on.
- Shooters can replace any lower position with a higher position at any time.
- There must be at least 5 shooters with one being from each team for a relay to start before 7pm.
- Any shooter who arrives by 9pm will be allowed to shoot for their team. Said shooter will be ready to shoot no later than 9:20 pm if all other shooters have finished.

New Western Rifle League Rules

- Empty Chamber Indicators will be required (Same as any NRA match)
- Rifles will not be handled in the range while people are down range servicing targets.
